## **APPLICATION DEADLINES AND BOARD MEETING DATES**

In order for your application to be presented to the Board, it must be completed in its entirety and be on file in the Board's office by the appropriate deadline below. The Board will not consider incomplete applications. The only exception to this requirement is the criminal background check. The Board may approve your application pending this item and a positive outcome.

## "Special" Licensure Items

In the event that your application is deemed to be a "special" licensure item, it will be presented to the Board on an individual basis. It is important to note that special licensure items are not eligible to receive a Temporary Permit. Due to the fact that special licensure items are presented at the Board's regularly scheduled meetings, it is imperative that applicants cooperate with the Board's medical licensure coordinators to meet the deadlines as set by the Board. The following are the deadline dates for "special" licensure items to be considered by the Board: **February 2, May 3, August 2, and October 25, 2024.** 

## **Temporary Permits**

Once your application is complete and you meet qualifications for licensure, you may request a Temporary Permit, which will allow you to start practicing for a period not to exceed six months and carry you over until the following Board meeting to be approved for a regular medical/osteopathic license.
